

The 2022 Breakdown Basketball Shot Clock Classic's @ Anoka-Ramsey Community College

Girls Event – Wednesday, June 15th

Boys Event – Tuesday, June 28th

- 1) Officials are asked to officiate, one basketball game, using 3-person mechanics, the game is being played under MSHSL rules. Officials will not be paid, but will not have to pay for the clinic/camp setting, that they will be working in.
- 2) The games will be observed by a MSHSL observer.
- 3) Each official will get a written observation.
- 4) Each official will get a link to the game that they worked for them to study and compare the notes from their observations.
- 5) Rob Kueneman, Men's College Assigner, will be in attendance on Tuesday, June 28th.
- 6) First game is at 9:00am and last game at 7:30pm on June 15th (the June 28th schedule is not set yet, but will be similar)
- 7) If you are coming from an outstate location, and are bringing a 'crew', just let us know, and we'll have you work together, if you wish or split you up, so you can work with other officials.

It is our hope that this event can be used to get officials in front of MSHSL observers and their association assignors, in hopes that it will improve the quality of games they receive in the upcoming season and possibly lead to a state tournament invitation.
